Guidelines for Related Resources

Related Resources are the way for Policies to have resources from the Web attached to them. For Example: If a policy relies on a section of the MS Code, that section of the MS Code could be connect to the Policy as a Related Resource.

Related Resources can be attached to the Policy during editing, or after the policy is live on the Policy Administration System.

Two pieces of information are needed to add a Related Resource:

- ✓ First, type the name of the Related Resource in the Name text box. This is what users on the web will see. The name will be a link for them to click.
- ✓ Next type the URL in its text box. This is the address that the user will be directed to by clicking the Name, or link. The URL must include http:// or https://.
